

OVERVIEW

Our Art & Quilting in Japan tour is a gateway to the tradition at the heart of Japan's fiber-art heritage.

Start our tour in Tokyo, the capital city of Japan and enjoy shopping trips to retail sites such as the Blue and White Shop and Nippori Fabric Town.

Then travel to Kawaguchi Lake, Kyoto, and Arimatsu. On this leg of the tour, an en route stop at the Itchiku Kubota Museum provides a view of the Kubota Kimono Collection and majestic Mt. Fuji. Fushimi Inari Shrine and its thousands of orange torii gates set the stage to experience Old Japan. Hands-on workshops introduce you to Shibori at the Narumi Shibori Museum and to Yuzen painting and Roketsu dyeing in Kyoto studios. Additional venues include the Orinasukan Handmade Fabrics Museum; the Kyoto Museum of Crafts and Design, famous for indigo dyeing. You also will explore the Gion District, a Geisha quarter in Kyoto.

Plus, feast in traditional Japanese food and make your own sushi on this immersive 10-day journey.

TOUR HIGHLIGHTS



TOKYO

Tokyo's modern face and popular attractions make it a leading international destination, drawing 15.2 million visitors in 2019. From exquisite cuisine and museums to craft markets and the Imperial Palace East Garden, Tokyo offers a memorable blend of cultural experiences.



KYOTO

In Kyoto, visitors discover the cultural heart of Japan. Once the nation's capital, this city of 1.5 million residents retains and offers a sense of Old Japan. It is resplendent with temples, shrines, traditional crafts, and other must-see points of interest.



TEXTILE WORKSHOPS

Hands-on workshops in Yuzen painting and two dyeing techniques – Shibori and Rocketstu wax resist – connect you with generations of Japanese craftspeople. As you work with talented artisans in studio settings, you gain a deep appreciation for these time-honored processes.



JAPANESE TEXTILES

Japanese Textiles suggests the luscious silks of Kimonos and beautiful blues of indigo. There is so much more. Tokyo Nippori Fabric Town is street after street of textile bliss. Explore indigo dyer's shops in Kyoto. Arimatsu offers Shibori in every form imaginable. Antique kimonos, Tenugui Towels, Furoshiki cloths, and Indigo are just a few things you will be tempted by.



DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 Wed Mar 2

Arrive Tokyo

Meet your tour leader at hotel lobby and start our tour at 1 pm. We'll stroll through the beautiful **Imperial Palace East Garden**, and visit the world-famous quilter Yoko Saito's retail shop **Quilt Party**. This quilt store specializes in quilting, fabric, and patchwork materials needed for any craft project. Enjoying a group **welcome dinner** tonight. (D)

Day 2 Thu Mar 3

Tokyo

After breakfast, we make a visit to **Akie Ginza's** remarkable **Sashiko Museum** in the small village of Hinohara. Housed in a 200 year old house, it's filled with her sashiko work, apparel, wall hangings, handbags, jewelry and home décor and more. Then visit **Meiji Jingu Inner Garden**, a secret garden within the Meiji Shrine complex. In the afternoon, we make a stop at a special shop - **Blue and White**, which houses artisan ceramics, designer clothing, traditional textiles, fun jewelry, collectibles, and gifts. (B)

Day 3 Fri Mar 4

Tokyo

We start our day with a visit to the historical **Edo Museum**. Then attend a **Japanese cooking class** to enjoy a Sushi making experience and lunch. We also make a stop at **Amy Katoh's home** before visiting the historic **Nippori Fabric Town**, home to nearly 100 shops carrying all sorts of fabric and notions. (B)

Day 4 Sat Mar 5

Tokyo-Kawaguchiko Lake

Today we travel to Kawaguchi Lake, we make a stop at the beautiful **Itchiku Kubota Museum** to see the stunning Kubota Kimono Collection. This museum contains the works of the textile artist Itchiku Kubota who revived the traditional fabric dyeing technique of Tsujigahana. Also visit **Fujisan World Heritage Centre** on the way. This evening we enjoy the view of Mt Fuji, from our onsen hotel. (B, D)

Day 5 Sun Mar 6

Kawaguchiko Lake-Odawara-Kyoto

Today we bid farewell to Kawaguchi Lake and make our way to Kyoto where we visit the popular **Kiyomizudera Temple**. Its classic red pagoda has been influential to Japanese architecture for centuries. Stroll along the street of **Kiyomizu-Zaka** where the narrow lanes, wooden buildings and traditional merchant shops invoke a feeling of the old capital city. We'll end our day with a walk through Kyoto's best known Geisha quarter – the **Gion District**. (B)

Day 6 Mon Mar 7

Kyoto

This morning we visit **Yoshiko Jinzenji's studio** in the Mount Hiei region north of Kyoto. Yoshiko Jinzenji is one of the foremost quilt artists in the world. In the studio we'll be able to view a variety of her finished quilts and homeware pieces and yardage with

her printed designs. Then, we participate in a **Roketsu dyeing workshop** using a traditional wax-resist dyeing method. Yamamoto Roketsu is a family operated workshop continuing this traditional Kyoto textile dyeing technique. A special trip today includes a visit to **Orinasukan Handmade Fabrics Museum**. Originally a machiya townhouse built as a home and weaving workshop, this hand-weaving museum, with its atrium, skylights, big beams, tatami reception room and courtyard garden to the rear, the same today as when it was originally lived and worked in. (B)

Day 7 Tue Mar 8 **Kyoto-Arimatsu-Kyoto**

Today we travel by Bullet Train to **Arimatsu** – the center of Shibori dyeing dating back to the early 17th century. We will visit the **Narumi Shibori Museum** and participate in a **Shibori-dyeing workshop**. We have the opportunity to explore the town before returning to Kyoto. (B)

Day 8 Wed Mar 9 **Kyoto**

This morning we visit the **Little Indigo Museum** owned by renowned Indigo Dyeing artist Hiroyuki Shindo. Then we visit the spectacular **Kinkakuji Temple**, known as the **Golden Pavilion**. The temple's stunning gold leaf coating makes it one of Japan's must-see structures. Also visit Japan's most famous rock garden, **Ryoanji Temple**. The garden consists of a rectangular plot of pebbles surrounded by low earthen walls, with 15 rocks laid out in small groups on patches of moss. Before returning to our hotel, we make a stop at **Nishijin Textile Center** to see up close the weaving, dyeing and design processes of Japanese kimonos. (B)

Day 9 Thu Mar 10 **Kyoto**

This morning we visit the intriguing **Fushimi Inari Shrine**. The magical, seemingly unending path of over 5000 vibrant orange torii gates that wind through the hills behind Fushimi Inari-taisha Shrine makes it one of the most popular shrines in Japan. Afterward, create your own masterpiece in the **Yuzen painting workshop**. Yuzen is a dyeing-technique that originated in the middle of the Edo period, toward the end of the 17th century. Then visit the **Kyoto Museum of Crafts and Design** (formerly the Kyoto Museum of Traditional Crafts Fureaikan). Later we visit the iconic **Nomura Tailor**, one of the world's best sewing and needlecraft shops. Tonight, we enjoy our **farewell dinner** in a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 10 Fri Mar 11 **Depart Kyoto**

Our tour ends after breakfast. Transfer to the airport for your onward flight. (B)





Price per person (Land Tour):

The tour price is \$4,550 per person, twin share (land content only). The supplement for a twin or double room for sole use is \$920 per person. A deposit of \$500 per person is required to secure a place on the tour.
